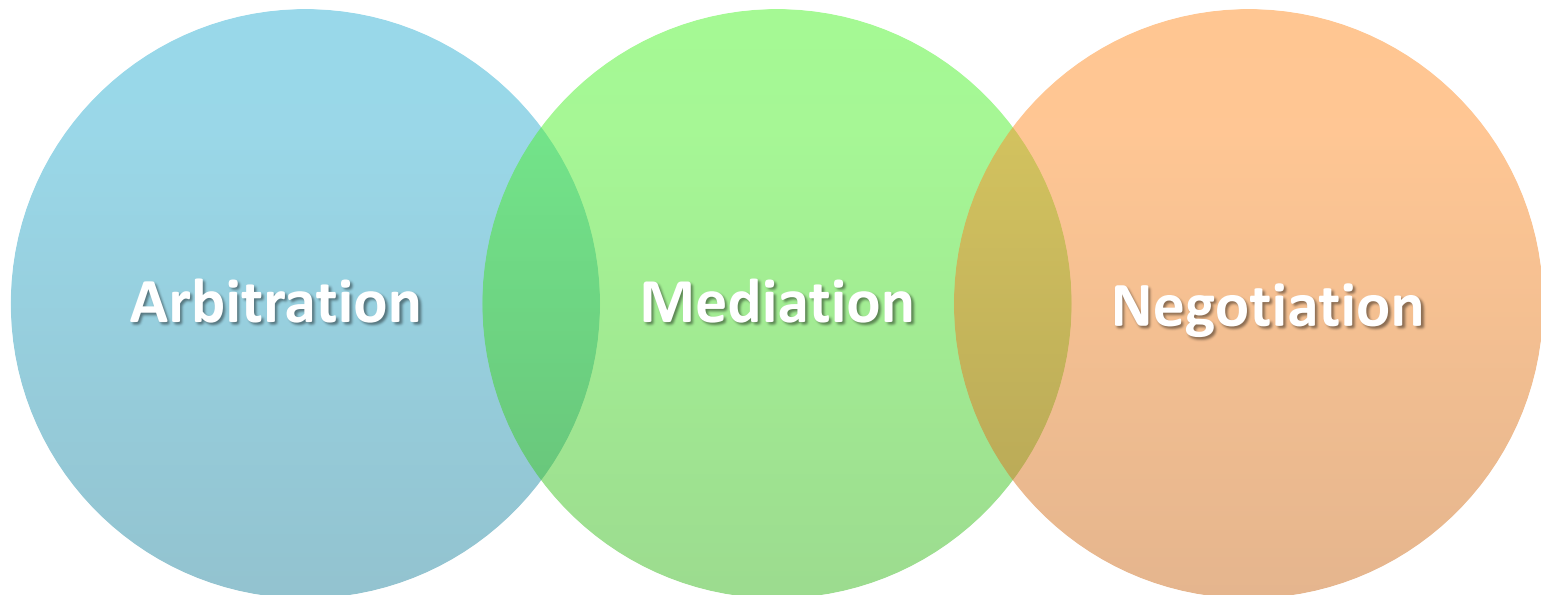

What is ADR?

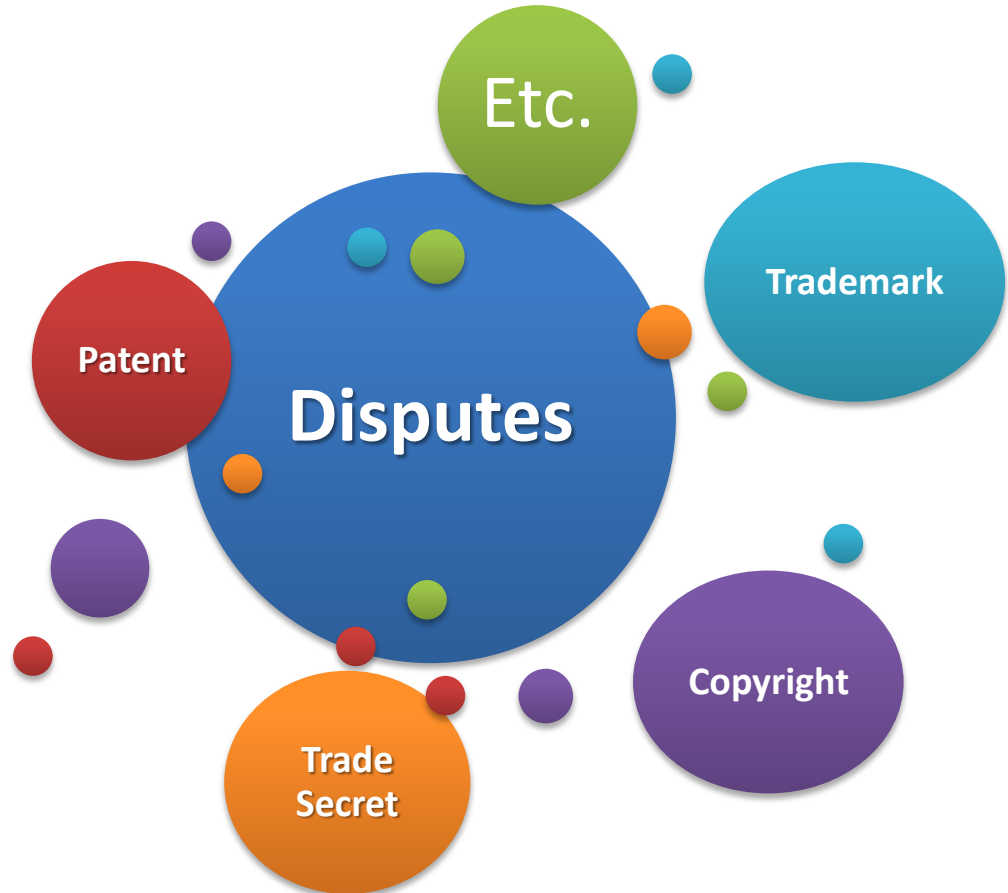
ADR stands for “Alternative Dispute Resolution,” which refers to any means of resolving disputes outside of court





Advantages of ADR

- **Better efficiency & lower cost**
- **Better suited to solving transnational disputes**
- **Party autonomy**
- **Confidentiality**
