In response to digital technology

The partial draft amendment of the Copyright Act was **submitted** in 2021 (40 articles involved), awaiting review

In response to Covid-19

Copyright L&E for distance learning / textbook preparation / digital archive (4 articles) were passed in 2022 and took effect on June 15, 2022.



In-Person and Distance Learning §46

- Subject: all levels of legally established schools and their teachers
- Scope of Use: within the scope necessary for the purposes of teaching of courses

In-Person Teaching

Reproduction, Adaptation, Distribution, Public Performance, Public Presentation

shall not conflict with a normal exploitation of the work or unreasonably prejudice the legitimate interests of the author

Permitted Use

Distance Teaching


Public Broadcast, Public Transmission Requirement:

adopt reasonable technical measures to prevent access by persons who have not registered in the school or have not enrolled in the course



Not-for-profit Distance Learning §46 bis

- > Subject: all levels of legally established schools or educational institutions and their teachers
- Scope of Use: within the scope necessary for the purposes of education



For-profit Distance Teaching: must obtain authorization from the economic rights holder



Preparation of Textbooks §47

Subject: preparation of textbooks and supplementary teaching aids (except those for college use)

Textbooks

Reproduction, Adaptation, Compilation, Distribution

Public Transmission

Supplementary Teaching Aids (exclusively for teachers)

Reproduction, Adaptation, Compilation, Distribution

notify the economic rights holder and pay equitable remuneration for use (set by the competent authority)



Digital Archive & Limited Access §48

TYPE 1

- Subject: National Central Library
- Purpose of Use: promote cultural development
- Scope of Use: digitize collections (in order to preserve them) (shall not apply to works already available on the market in digital form)

TYPE 2

- > Subject: National Central Library and other archival institutions
- Scope of Use: offering limited access to digitized collections within the institution

*availability for access shall not exceed quantity of the collection *patrons' reproduction and public transmission are not allowed
