## Appendix 2

- I. The Trademark Act contains the following stipulations regarding the <u>statutory period</u> for applying for reinstatement:
  - (1) Period for claiming patent priority and exhibition priority for international applications (Paragraph 1 of Article 20; Paragraph 1 of Article 21)
  - (2) Period for resubmitting documentation for priority claims (Paragraph 4 of Article 20)
  - (3) Period for payment of trademark registration fee (Paragraph 2 of Article 32)
  - (4) Period for the application of a renewal of trademark registration (Paragraph 1 of Article 34)
  - (5) Period for filing grounds for opposition to a registered trademark (Paragraph 1 of Article 48)
  - (6) Period for filing invalidations against a trademark registration (Paragraph 1 of Article 58)
- II. According to Paragraph 4 of Article 8 of the Trademark Act, the applicant may not apply for reinstatement during the statutory period for reinstatement, due to unintentional failure to pay for the registration fee (Paragraph 3 of Article 32).
